

PARTICIPANTS GUIDELINES

- Teams must be formed before the event and details should be submitted during abstract submissions. Teams can consist of 1 to 5 participants.
- The intended idea must be announced before the hackathon begins along with the coding details which are to be used by the participants.
- Participants must nominate their group leader before the start of the Hack.
- It is highly recommended for all the participants attend the webinar and post their queries before or during the webinar.
- Workshop/webinar will occur on 15th January 2019. The time and link will be provided to registered participants by 13th January 2019.
- Each Team must code for a minimum of 12 hours on site. (6 hours per day)
- Participants should not bring completed product or solution to the Hackathon. A finished product before the hackathon start would be disqualified.
- All projects need to be submitted at the time designated by the organizers.
- Participants will have 5 minutes to demonstrate the functionality of their programs and present their ideas.
- The judges will have 2 minutes to further discuss and ask relevant questions to the participants.
- WIFI will be provided onsite.
- Participants are expected to bring all required equipment including laptops and networking cables, etc. to efficiently develop their solutions.

Rules and responsibilities

- Dates & Timings: 21 January 2019 – 22 January 2019, The Hack will start at 09:30 on 21st Jan. 2019 – will end at 15:30 (Gulf Standard Time) on 22nd January 2019
- Allocation of space: Teams are allocated Spaces to work from by the Dubai Health Hack Team and these are non-Transferable or negotiable.
- Products given by DHH at the event: All Participants are provided with the following:

- ✓ A Table space to work as a team Maximum of 5 hackers per station
 - ✓ WIFI Access for all Participants
 - ✓ Electric Connection for laptop computers (5 connections per table)
 - ✓ 1. Flip Chart for each team
 - ✓ Stationary: Pens, markers, sticky notes and note pads.
- DHH & MCI will not be held responsible for the loss of any belongings onsite.
 - Badges are allocated to each participant and are not transferrable.
 - Participants are required to safeguard their badges as they will not be replaced under any circumstances.
 - A participant will be required to show their badge upon admission into the Hackathon and must wear their badges always.
 - Participants will be required to sign in/sign out via a scan when entering/leaving the hackathon area.

Sleeping/Rest

- No sleeping bags are allowed inside the venue. The following rooms will be provided:
- Team size 1 -3 (all male or female participants) – 1 room
- Team size 1-3 (Male and female participants) – 2 rooms
- Team size 4-5 - 2 rooms
